Accepting his award is Raymond Campbell, lives in Alice Springs, Northern Territory and is an Arunda Kadig (*kadj-ik*) man.

He has displayed great passion and commitment in his work within Indigenous communities, providing support, knowledge and training, travelling to and counselling extended family members living in remote areas, and actively seeking out families to provide support even when he himself has been personally affected by the loss of a family member.

Raymond conducts workshops with Indigenous participants, raising awareness amongst communities in suicide intervention/prevention and postvention, and is well known through his work and dedication to government and non-government services in the Territory.

Raymond works as an Indigenous "Life Promotion" officer, as an Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Trainer, as a non-clinical Aboriginal Mental Health Worker and is currently completing his apprenticeship through Northern Territory Health to become a clinical Aboriginal Health Worker.
